The competition will take the form of a Fourball Betterball Competition over 18 holes. Scoring by Stableford System. Players will receive a handicap allowance of 7/8 of their handicaps.
The Competition is limited to amateur golfers who are members of recognised Golf Clubs.
Please bring a handicap certificate verified by your Club Secretary to the Competition.
Starting times will be posted to the competitor whose name is on the accepted entry form and it will be his responsibility for notifying his partner.
The Club reserves the right to refuse an entry without specifying a reason.
Competitors will be made temporary Members of the Club for the day of the event.
All disputes shall be settled by the Competition Committee, whose decision will be final.
In the event of a tie, the rules of the Lancashire Union of Golf Clubs shall apply.
Jeans or collar-less shirts are not allowed on the course or in the Clubhouse at anytime.
Men are not permitted to wear shorts in the Clubhouse unless in designated areas.
Jackets and ties must be worn in the Dining Room after 8.00pm.
